3	Academic & Co-Scholastic updates	All the updates -activities / events, etc., held were presented through a PPT.



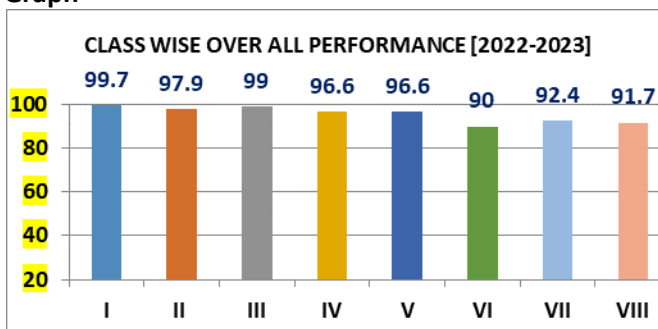
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#### Term-1 Graph
