

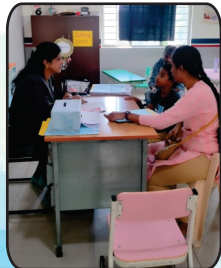

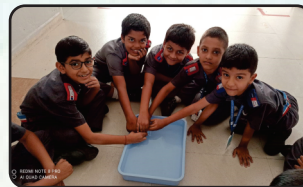

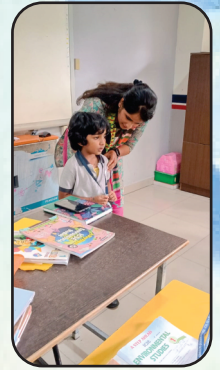


## Air in Action: Understanding its Properties and Movement

# Managing Anger: Empowering our Children to Embrace Emotions!



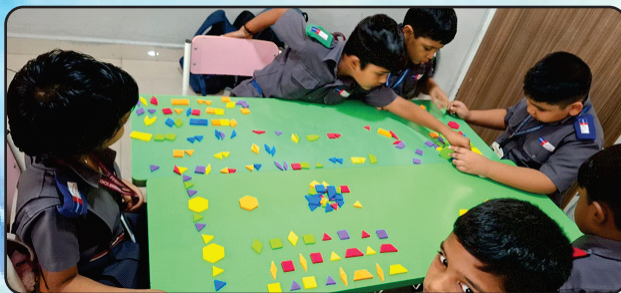
